23 The Court, having noted the appearance of Deputy Attorney General Sheronda L.
24 Edwards on behalf of the California Professional Fiduciaries Bureau (Bureau), having read and
25 considered the moving papers, oral and written arguments, and having heard and considered any
26 objections on behalf of defendant Gregory Kent Oveross, finds that good cause supports the
27 application of the Bureau pursuant to Penal Code section 23, and that under the current

1 circumstances it is appropriate to impose reasonable restrictions on defendant Gregory Kent
2 Oveross' Professional Fiduciary License, No. PF 312, in the interest of public safety.

3 IT IS ORDERED THAT defendant Gregory Kent Oveross is prohibited from engaging,
4 either directly or indirectly, in any activity for which a professional fiduciary license is required.
5 This condition shall remain in effect until there is a final disposition of this criminal case or until
6 further ordered by the Court.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

- 8 1. Defendant shall, within seven (7) days of the date of this Order or release from custody,
9 notify all currently appointed trustees, executors, agents, or managers of any trust fund,
10 or estate for which defendant is serving as a professional fiduciary of the court-ordered
11 suspension of defendant's authority to practice, and shall provide each such person
12 with a copy of this Order.
- 13 2. Defendant shall, within seven (7) days of the date of this Order or release from custody,
14 notify the civil court or probate court in each pending proceeding in which defendant
15 appears or is involved as a professional fiduciary, and shall provide each such court
16 with a copy of this Order.
- 17 3. Defendant shall, within seven (7) days of the date of this Order or release from custody,
18 provide to the Acting Bureau Chief of the Professional Fiduciaries Bureau a complete
19 list of all conservatorships, estates, trusts, probate matters, and other matters in which
20 defendant has been retained, including, where applicable, the address, contact
21 information, and court case number associated with each matter.
